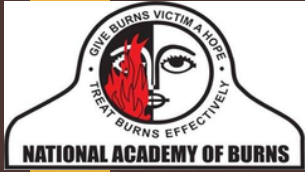

The meeting will be broadly classified in the following Sessions:

1. Burn critical care
2. Pediatric burn
3. Clinical /basic research in burn which is more useful in Indian context
4. Evidence based wound care
5. Miscellaneous

WHO CAN REGISTER:

1. Medical students
2. Residents/ PHD scholars/ Fellows

HOW TO REGISTER:

1. Register for the NABI MID TERM CME on <https://pages.razorpay.com/nabicme2023>. (Registration fee: 1000/-)
2. Choose a research paper which had significant impact on the burn care which was published in last 2 years in any of the reputed journal (Lancet, NEJM, Burns , Journal of burn care & research, PRS, Annals of Plastic Surgery, Archives of Plastic Surgery, Indian journal of burns, Journal of Wound Care. However other reputed journals with good impact factor can also be included.
3. Register for the "MID TERM NABI Year in Review" before 31st December 2022 on <https://forms.gle/QXCz7q4PM15okTkF8>
4. Prepare a presentation and email to us before 7th January 2023.
5. In case of duplication of the presentations, the presenter who has first registered for the session will be given preference for the session.
6. Present the research during the CME either on offline/online mode.
7. Attractive prizes will be awarded to best presentations.

HOW TO PRESENT:

1. 7 min oral presentation + 1 min discussion
2. Prepare a PowerPoint presentation with 10-12 slides. (2 slides for Introduction, 3 slides for aims and methodology, 3 slides for results, 2 slides for discussion/conclusion and 1 slide explaining the utility in Indian context.
